HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 152

Honorable Speaker Tripp and Members of the House:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return HOUSE BILL 70, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Second Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

While I am sympathetic to the intent of this legislation, and while assisted listening technologies—such as telecoil and loop technology—can be of high value to individuals who experience hearing loss, I am concerned about the widespread disagreement over this bill among members of the hard-of-hearing community and those who assist it. The lack of consensus about the best solution to this problem is apparent, and I am also concerned about mandating in statute specific standards of care, specific technologies that must be presented to patients, and specific conduct for audiologists and hearing aid dispensers.


